



4. Number of Published Articles in 2017




49 articles were published from April to December 2017.

5. Diversity of Articles Published in 2017




In 2017, ARH published

6. International Diversity of Corresponding Authors in 2017




Corresponding authors of 49 articles published in 2017 come from 15 countries, with 20% of them from the USA.
